

Report On "Legal Awareness Programme on Child Labour and Sexual Harassment on 20th September 2022

Viswa Bharathi College of Law, Muthangi, Sangareddy has conducted Legal Aid Camp in Z.P School Muthangi".

Objective: The main objective of this legal aid camp is to create awareness among Child Labour and Sexual Harassment.

Child Labour: It is important that the family business does not involve dangerous substances or processes (the term in law is 'hazardous' occupation or process). The law tells us what jobs are considered hazardous. Mines, explosives and processes involved in the coal, power generation industries etc are included. However, parents or guardians of the children who make their child work in violation of the law can be punished with a fine of up to Rs. 10,000.

According to (Section 354A IPC), Sexual harassment is the:

- Unwelcome touching or other physical contact
- Asking or demanding sex or any other sexual activity
- Making remarks which are of a sexual nature
- Showing pornographic material which may include videos, magazines, books etc.

Opening: Dr M Bhavani Madam, Principal of VBCL and Varsha Faculty of VBCL the in charge of legal Aid Cell, has made opening marks explaining the meaning of Legal Aid to the Students and the Importance of Legal Awareness and need to access them.

Skit: The students played a skit by explaining the importance of Child Labour and Sexual Harassment and what are the Provisions are being provided under State Government.
